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# The Multifamily Housing Resource Program

The Multifamily Housing Resource Program (MHRP) is a trailblazing membership program for housing industry leaders, dedicated to assisting multifamily housing developers comply with federal, state and local accessibility requirements, and increasing the number of accessible apartments and condominiums in the United States.

The MHRP's philosophy is grounded in the belief that companies that proactively embrace compliance with fair housing and accessibility laws not only create sound business models, but become valued community partners and leaders.

Since its founding in 2008, the MHRP has grown to include 14 developers representing more than 600,000 apartments and condominiums across the country, two architectural design and accessibility firms, and two product and service vendors. These industry leaders serve as a model for the housing industry, and give many of the nation's 57 million individuals with disabilities the opportunity to live where they choose.

# Membership Levels

At the suggestion of members, in 2012 the MHRP established a three-tiered membership: Executive, Advisory and Associate. In late 2013, American Standard Brands paved the way for accessibility product and service vendors by becoming the Founding Associate Member of the MHRP. American Standard Releases the AccessPRO® Right Height Elongated Toilet with Seat

Founding Associate Member American Standard released the AccessPRO® toilet on March 1. The AccessPRO® is an innovative design that saves time and money relocating toilets toward or away from the secondary wall to meet accessibility standards. It allows up to 3-1/2" (89mm) of lateral adjustment of the toilet to the right or left. The AccessPRO® offers the following:

- Two-piece, High Efficiency Toilet (HET), ultra-low consumption (4.8 Lpf/1.28 gpf), and meets EPA Water Sense® criteria.
- Allows up to 3-1/2" (89 mm) of lateral adjustment of toilet to the right (or left when used with left hand bowl) — no floor flange outlet change required.
- · Helps conform to needs of Americans with Disabilities Act and Fair Housing Act.
- Includes floor template, adjustable trapway kit, and slow-close seat for easy installation.
- 3" flush valve, 2-1/8" trapway, 12" rough-in, and 16-1/2" Right Height® elongated rim height for accessible application.

#### FHA Checklist

The MHRP released and distributed a new resource publication for multifamily housing developers to better ensure compliance with federal standards regarding accessible housing for people with disabilities.

Developed with support by funding under a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Fair Housing Act Checklist: A Guide to Accessible Design and Construction Compliance is a tool for multifamily housing developers that outlines accessibility requirements for design and construction as stipulated in the federal Fair Housing Act.

MHRP members received copies of the checklist in November.







# Available Trainings

The MHRP offers access to a variety of trainings designed to promote housing accessibility.

#### Basic Fair Housing

This training includes: information on the background and history of the Fair Housing Act and other laws that impact housing; discusses federal, state and local protected classes; examines common scenarios related to fair housing compliance; and details how to handle reasonable accommodation and modification requests.

#### Advanced Fair Housing for Supervisors

This training includes: information on the background and history of the Fair Housing Act and other laws that impact housing; discusses federal, state and local protected classes; examines common scenarios related to fair housing compliance; details how to handle reasonable accommodation and modification requests; analyzes emerging trends in fair housing; and provides information on how to give basic FHA information to new staff address any questions that may arise.

### Source of Income and other locally protected classes

This training includes: information on the background and history of the Fair Housing Act and other laws that impact housing; discusses federal, state and local protected classes; provides an overview of the Housing Choice Voucher program; examines common scenarios related to fair housing compliance; and details how to handle reasonable accommodation and modification requests.

### Reasonable Accommodations and Reasonable Modifications for Property Managers

This training focuses on the requirements of property managers to allow reasonable accommodations and modifications to people with disabilities.

#### Accessible Design and Construction

This training focuses on the accessible design requirements as they pertain to newly constructed multifamily buildings under the federal Fair Housing Act.

#### Sensitivity in the Workplace

This training includes: participating in awareness-raising activities; defining and discussing culture and workplace diversity; discussing self-awareness; and sharing communication tools.

#### Underserved Population Sensitivity

This training focuses on best practices for working with immigrants, LEP/NEP communities, LGBTQ individuals and people with disabilities.
