We are seeking bilingual or multi-lingual individuals to work on a part-time, as-needed basis on a civil rights research project.

- Must live in or near Washington DC
- Must be proficient in written and spoken English, and **fluent in Mandarin Chinese.**
- Must be able to follow detailed instructions and complete accurate written reports in English.

Compensation: ERC will pay \$20/hour for completing an initial online training and a **minimum** of \$23/hour for work on project assignments. In some cases, participants may earn more. ERC will also reimburse for travel to locations in Washington DC, which will be required for some assignments.
